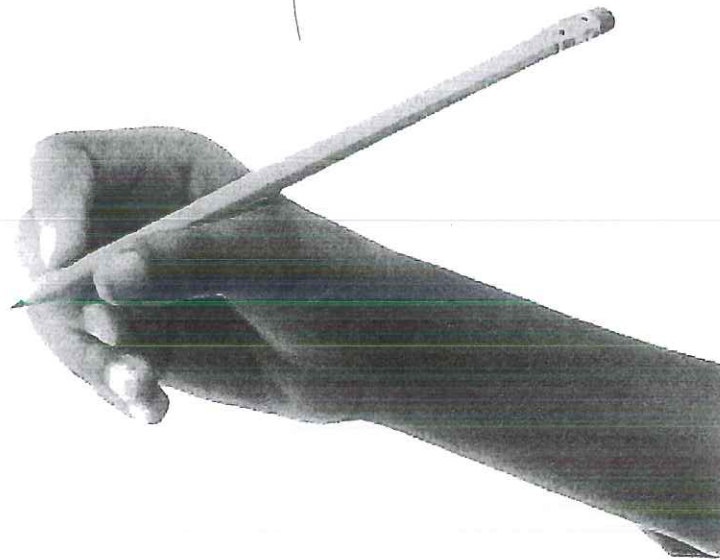

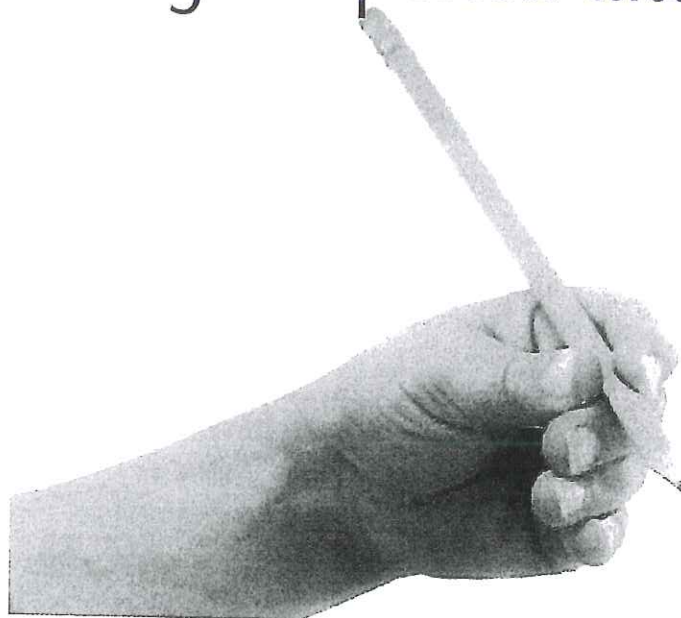

Expectations for the end of Nursery for Literacy:

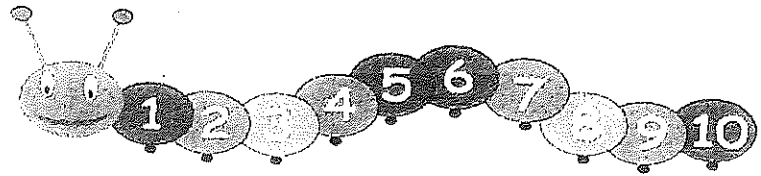
