Literacy




The children will be writing their own story, focusing on beginning each sentence with a capital letter and placing a full stop at the end of each sentence.

The children will re-visit poetry and recite nursery rhymes from memory. They will also be identifying rhyming words in poems.



The children will also explore non-fiction books, focusing on their features and how they are different to fiction books.

Maths



Please practise regularly with your children:

- doubles and halves
- addition facts to 10
- subtraction facts to 10



Place Value

To know the value of two digit numbers as tens and units.

To count and order numbers to 50



Shape

Describing shapes and using them to make pictures and patterns. Children to know the shapes by their mathematical names.

To be able to half and quarter shapes.

Science

We will be learning about Seasonal change, humans and animals in our local environment. We will look at the four seasons and continue our termly diary recording the changes in weather, temperature, different stages of growth and rainfall.
