

We would like to share with you the things we will be doing in Nursery this half term so you can support your child. Our topic this half term is **Traditional Stories**. We will also be talking about how Easter is celebrated and the children will be sharing their own family celebrations.

Weeks 1 & 2



- Making and eating porridge and talking about the changes we can see.
- Finding ways to organise our counting, adding small groups of objects and matching numbers to groups of objects.
- Making pictures with 2d and 3D shapes and describing the shapes: curved, flat, corners, sides, sphere.
- Learning how to use the remote control cars
- Putting the 3 bears in different places in their cottage and understanding and using positional language-on top, under, behind, next to, at the side, in front of.



Weeks 3 & 4

- Drawing and writing about our families
- Baking a Gingerbread man, learning how to use different tools in the kitchen and talking about the ingredients and how they change
- Counting and understanding more and less/fewer
- Understanding how to play safely when climbing and using stairs.

Weeks 5 & 6

- Writing cards to our families
- Using our scissor skills to make an Easter basket
- Making cards using materials with different textures and using words to describe the textures – bumpy, soft, hard, rough, smooth
- Finding out about Easter and talking about other celebrations
- Our Easter assembly

At story time we will be reading the following books:

- Goldilocks & the 3 bears (Traditional Tale)
- The Three Little Pigs (Traditional Tale)
- The Gingerbread Man (Traditional Tale)
- The 3 Billy Goats Gruff (Traditional Tale)
- The Little Red Hen (Traditional Tale)
- We're going on an Egg Hunt by Laura Hunt



We will be talking about the story characters, where the stories are set and putting the events of the stories in order.

The children will also be working on improving their pencil skills and forming letters correctly.


We will be learning the following rhymes and songs:

- Children to choose to sing their favourite rhymes and songs
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
We will be finding objects beginning with the letter sounds: , u, r, h, b, f and revising all of our letters this half term
