- Writing- Remember to write your name every day and form the letters correctly. Use the letter formation hand out sheets to remind you how to write the letters and look at ‘Get Squiggling Letters’ on the CBeebies page.

- Numbers- Use the number packs we gave you to work on your number targets. If you achieve your target just go on to higher numbers. Remember to count the cubes and the spots and match the numbers. You can use anything to count with at home such as pencils, cars, bricks.

Phonics

Watch Ruth teach phonics lessons to help your child learn to read at home. The daily Set 1 Speed Sounds lessons are for children in Nursery and Reception beginning to learn to read sounds and write letters and for children who are new to English.

Lessons show at 9.30 am, from Monday to Friday. Each one is ten minutes long and available for 24 hours. After the Easter holidays, Ruth will teach lessons to help your child spell words with Set 1 Speed Sounds.

Repeats of lessons streamed up until Friday 3rd April will be shown during the Easter holidays (excluding Bank Holidays). Don't worry if you miss a lesson. Once the whole set has been shown, we will replay one lesson a day.
