#### Humanities:

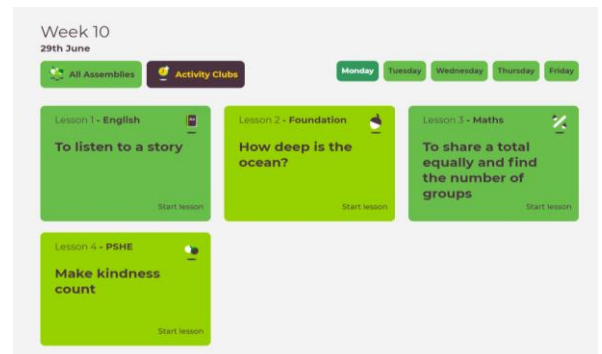
- How deep is the ocean?
