Practise segmenting and blending these words

Here are some different ways to practise:

<p>Read the word by segmenting the sounds: s - t - o - p then blend the sounds together: stop</p>	<p>Segment the word for an adult: g - o o - d ask the adult to blend the word: good listen carefully to check the adult blended correctly!</p>	<p>Ask an adult to segment the word for you: l - igh - t listen carefully so you can blend the word: light</p>


