Practise segmenting and blending these words

Here are some different ways to practise:

<p>Read the word by segmenting the sounds: s - t - o - p then blend the sounds together: stop</p>	<p>Segment the word for an adult: g - o o - d ask the adult to blend the word: good listen carefully to check the adult blended correctly!</p>	<p>Ask an adult to segment the word for you: l - igh - t listen carefully so you can blend the word: light</p>
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<p>ch chop chip chat chess charm</p>	<p>sh shop cash mash wish shark</p>	<p>th thin them thick thigh Thursday</p>	<p>ng king sing ring wing swing</p>
<p>ve give live have sleeve starve</p>	<p>wh wheel when whisk white* whale*</p>	<p>ai pain rain chain quail train</p>	<p>ee bee see tree three knee</p>

*words use long vowel sounds 'i' says 'ie' / 'i_e' 'a' says 'ai' / 'a_e'

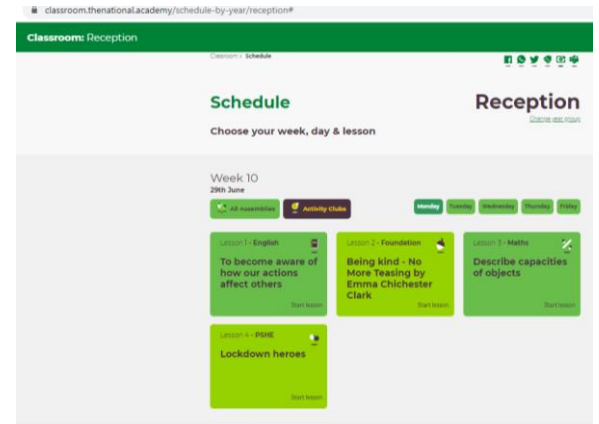
