

### 'HIGH' COVID ALERT LEVEL FOR LONDON

As you will have seen recently, London will be moving to a 'High' Local COVID Alert Level from midnight tonight. This means that:

- You are not allowed to meet socially with anyone who is not part of your household, or support bubble, indoors. This includes private homes, as well as pubs and restaurants.
- You can still meet friends and family outdoors, but only in a group of up to six people.

### REMINDERS

- **Please do not crowd around the classroom door** when collecting or dropping off children. Please **stand behind the white line, away from the classroom door** and maintain a 2-metre distance from other parents.
- **Please keep to the one-way system – for the Infant School, enter through the Nursery gate and exit using the Field gate.**



These rules are essential to the safety of the whole school community, and we thank the vast majority of parents who do keep to these rules.

### FLU VACCINATIONS

We would like to clarify that the flu vaccinations taking place on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> November **will not be for Nursery children** – the NHS scheme is only in place for children in Reception onwards. Parents of children in the Nursery should contact their GP to arrange a vaccination.
